A Glimpse of Back to Office

Most of our offices are back to business this week. We are all adapting to the new working set-up and are glad to see that those who are working in the office are following the social distancing and general rules to keep us safe and healthy.

Reminder: The following social distancing and health measures apply to all Yoma offices.

- Temperature screening on entry to the office
- Hand sanitisers available in all meeting rooms and reception desks
- Always observe 6 feet distance with work colleagues
- Desks to be marked with an X to ensure appropriate social distancing
- Staff to wear masks in the office when social distancing cannot be maintained
- Staff to wear a mask if in a meeting room with other colleagues
- Temperature screenings on the Pun Hlaing Estate and StarCity Estate will continue

Antibody Testing - To Create Safe Work-entry and a Safe Workplace

At Yoma Group our staff safety is paramount.

As we return to work, we will conduct COVID-19 antibody testing for selected employees, such as those in the front line and those who are at risk. This test helps us eliminate risk within our workforce.

What will the test results show?

A negative test indicates that the staff member is free to re-enter work and for such individuals we will repeat the test in 10 days' time. Two times negative result gives us a 99% assurance that staff will be infection free.

A positive test may indicate that an employee has an infection, or it could simply mean that the test is a false positive result and inconclusive.

What if I test positive?

If you are tested positive, the doctors at Pun Hlaing Siloam Hospital will run additional screening tests to see if you have any other sign and symptoms of COVID-19.

Just to be safe for you and your colleagues, any staff who is positive will be required to go into self-isolation at home with pay for 28 days to ensure that we all remain safe.




